## Line 3 of Form TD1 – Age amount

If you will be 65 or older on December 31, 2010, and your estimated net income from all sources will be between \$32,506 and \$75,480, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Base amount	– 32,506	00	3
Line 2 minus line 3 (if negative, enter "0")	=		4
Applicable rate	× 15%		5
Multiply line 4 by line 5	=		6
Line 1 minus line 6			
Enter this amount on line 3 of Form TD1.	=		7

## Line 9 of Form TD1 – Caregiver amount

If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$14,422 and \$18,645, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Base amount	18,645	00	1
Your dependant's estimated net income for the year	–		2
Line 1 minus line 2 (maximum \$4,223)	=		3
Enter the amount you claimed on line 8 of your TD1 form for this dependant	–		4
Line 3 minus line 4 Enter this amount on line 9 of Form TD1.	=		5

## Line 10 of Form TD1 – Amount for infirm dependants age 18 or

You cannot claim this amount for a dependant for whom you claimed the caregiver amount on line 9 of Form TD1.

If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$5,992 and \$10,215, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Base amount	10,215	00	1
Your infirm dependant's estimated net income for the year	–		2
Line 1 minus line 2 (maximum \$4,223)	=		3
Enter the amount you claimed on line 8 of your TD1 form for this dependant	–		4
Line 3 minus line 4 Enter this amount on line 10 of Form TD1.	=		5
