Line 2 of Form TD1BC – Age amount

If you will be 65 or older on December 31, 2012, and your estimated net income from all sources will be between \$32,424 and \$61,464, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Line 6 of Form TD1BC – Spouse or common-law partner amount

If your spouse's or common-law partner's estimated net income for the year (including the income earned before and during the marriage or common-law relationship) will be between \$996 and \$10,960, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Line 8 of Form TD1BC – Caregiver amount

If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$14,385 and \$18,635, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Line 9 of Form TD1BC – Amount for infirm dependants age 18 or older

You cannot claim this amount for a dependant for whom you claimed the caregiver amount on line 8 of Form TD1BC.

If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$6,770 and \$11,020, calculate your partial claim as follows:
