Complete this worksheet if you want to calculate partial claims for the following amounts on your Form TD1NT, 2012 Northwest Territories Personal Tax Credits Return.

Do not give your completed worksheet to your employer or payer. Keep it for your records.

**Line 2 of Form TD1NT – Age amount**

If you will be 65 or older on December 31, 2012, and your estimated net income from all sources will be between \$33,884 and \$77,191, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Line 2 minus line 3 (if negative, enter "0")	=			4			
Applicable rate	×	15%		5			
Multiply line 4 by line 5.	=						6
Line 1 minus line 6							
Enter this amount on line 2 of Form TD1NT.	=						7

**Line 8 of Form TD1NT – Caregiver amount**

If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$15,033 and \$19,435, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Base amount					19,435	00	1
Your dependant's estimated net income for the year	–			2			
Line 1 minus line 2 (maximum \$4,402)	=			3			
Enter the amount you claimed on line 7 of your TD1NT form for this dependant.	–			4			
Line 3 minus line 4							
Enter this amount on line 8 of Form TD1NT.	=						5

**Line 9 of Form TD1NT – Amount for infirm dependants age 18 or older**

You cannot claim this amount for a dependant for whom you claimed the caregiver amount on line 8 of Form TD1NT. If your dependant's estimated net income for the year will be between \$6,246 and \$10,648, calculate your partial claim as follows:

Line 1 minus line 2 (maximum \$4,402)	=			3			
Enter the amount you claimed on line 7 of your TD1NT form for this dependant.	–			4			
Line 3 minus line 4							
Enter this amount on line 9 of Form TD1NT.	=						5
